Scholarship Description:

Fort Worth Music Therapy Fund provides **Intern Scholarships** to music therapy students completing an internship as part of their university course requirements for an accredited music therapy degree program.

Each Intern Scholarship:

- is \$2,500
- Is paid directly to the music therapy intern

Eligibility: This scholarship is only available to music therapy interns completing accredited music therapy degree programs from universities in the state of Texas OR completing internships at sites in Texas. Applicants must be completing an internship program with a board-certified music therapist. Scholarships are awarded biannually. Any intern who is interning ON the next due date of this application (2/28 or 8/31) is eligible for consideration. Applications received September 1 through February 28 will be reviewed in March. Applications received March 1 through August 31 will be reviewed in September.

Applications:

- Applications are accepted year-round and scholarships are awarded biannually. Applications received on or before February 28 will be reviewed in March. Applications received on or before August 31 will be reviewed in September.
